Heart disease

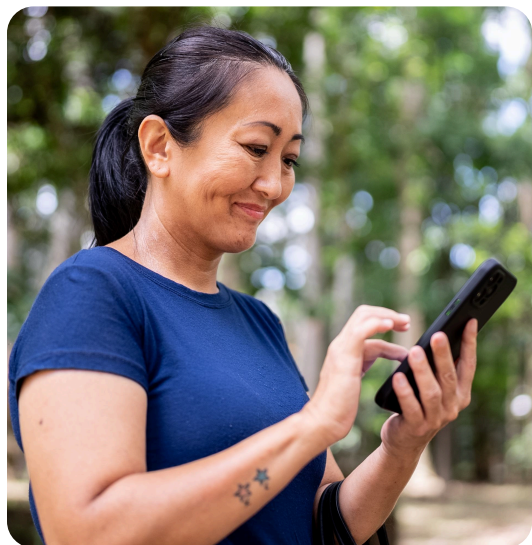


